Areas the Selection Committee will consider include:

- Passion for teaching
- Proficiency in delivering clear and relevant information
- Appropriateness of teaching for the student's skill level and ability
- Effectiveness in responding to client's needs
- Modeling professional practice and behaviors
- Commitment to the CMO philosophy of care statement
- Interest in student's personal development and well-being
- Commitment to the evaluation process (e.g. Providing feedback regularly, encouraging discussion and questioning about clinical activities etc.)
- Use of innovative teaching techniques
- Use of evidence-based research to teach clinical skills
- Ability to balance student learning needs with appropriate clinical care
