Assessment

Competency will be confirmed through knowledge assessment in the form of online examination and reliable demonstration of safe practice in the clinical setting.

- A passing grade for the exam is 70%. The exam will be written after completion of the online modules prior to attending theworkshop. It is comprised of multiple choice questions
- Competency is required for surgical first assist at both primary and repeat caesarean births and where possible, abdominal hysterectomies. A fully qualified obstetrician or general surgeon will sign the competency based clinical assessment.

Confirmation of registration

A written acknowledgement of your registration will be sent prior to the activity. Receipts are emailed at the time of registration and an additional email will be sent after the activity, confirming your certificate of attendance. Your registration is not complete unless a confirmation is received. If you have not received a confirmation within 7 days of registration, please contact us.
